Constitutional Bodies

- Created directly by provisions of the Constitution.
- Their composition, tenure and removal rules are frequently tested.
- Examples include the Election Commission, Finance Commission and UPSC.

Parliament

- A bill and an Act are not the same: a bill becomes law after the required legislative process and assent.
- Money Bills have a special constitutional procedure.
- Committees strengthen detailed scrutiny and executive accountability.

Federalism

- Legislative subjects are distributed through the Union, State and Concurrent Lists.
- Intergovernmental institutions support coordination.
- Emergency provisions can alter the normal federal balance.
